



Information Hubs

Bushwick Open Studios takes place over three square miles of North Brooklyn and neighboring areas in Queens. To help you get oriented we've designated locations to act as informational hubs. These hubs are often near public transportation. At each hub space, you will find Arts in Bushwick volunteers who can provide you with assistance, maps, and other promotional materials. Volunteers can also help you learn about the various studios and events in that particular area during the festival.

Bushwick Open Studios 101

What? Bushwick Open Studios is a self-organized, collaborative festival produced by Arts in Bushwick, an all-volunteer community organization. Now in its fifth year, Bushwick Open Studios is an exciting opportunity for artists to experiment outside the standard context of sales and space competition. In addition, it provides a space for artists and community members to come together to collaboratively produce an event that showcases a wide range of what their neighborhood has to offer.

Who? More than 2,000 participants in over 350 separate activities will open their studios, share their work in group shows, perform in events, and showcase community spaces and projects. Bushwick community members and local organizations are encouraged to participate by presenting art, organizing activities, and assisting with festival operations.

Where? Festival activities take place in a myriad of venues and environments, including galleries, theaters, homes, artist studios, local businesses, non-profit organizations, parks, street corners, and other public spaces. In all, the festival includes over 175 separate locations in a three square mile area.

When? Bushwick Open Studios is a three-day event, running from June 3-5, 2011. On Friday, June 3rd, the Festival begins with a focus on the neighborhood's community organizations. The official BOS2011 Opening Party will be held that night, in addition to a number of openings and other evening events. Hundreds of shows, activities and events will be held during the day and into the night Saturday, June 4th and Sunday, June 5th, culminating in the official Festival closing party on Sunday night. While the suggested hours for daytime activities are 12-7pm on Saturday and Sunday, participants are welcome to set their own hours, so make sure to check the program listings for information about specific shows.

Why? The purpose of the festival is to create an open and inclusive event that benefits the Bushwick community through sharing artistic projects, encouraging dialogue, and fostering community engagement throughout our neighborhood.

What is Arts in Bushwick?

Arts in Bushwick is an all volunteer organization that serves and engages artists and local residents through creative accessibility and community organizing. It is our goal to create an integrated and sustainable neighborhood, and to bring together all Bushwick residents and stakeholders to counter developmentdriven displacement.

BOS2011 is our fifth birthday! Arts in Bushwick was founded in 2007, as a result of grassroots efforts to produce Bushwick Open Studios 2007. The organization has two core functions – producing neighborhood arts festivals, and facilitating community projects and dialogue. All of our activities are produced by volunteers and presented at no cost to the public. Arts In Bushwick maintains a completely open structure, inviting all community members to bring their ideas and to participate in collaboratively producing the organization and its activities. We're thrilled to have a growing, supportive and engaged group of participants as our core.


